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Annex A: Student Acceptable Use of ICT Agreement Form

## 1. Purpose

1.1 The Acceptable Use of ICT Policy purpose is to ensure:

- that young people will be responsible users and stay safe while using the internet and other digital technologies for educational, personal and recreational use.
- that academy systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse that could put the security of the systems and users at risk.

1.2 The academy will try to ensure that students / pupils will have good access to digital technologies to enhance their learning and will, in return, expect the students / pupils to agree to be responsible users.

## 2. Acceptable Use of ICT agreement

I understand that I must use Academy ICT systems in a responsible way, to ensure that there is no risk to my safety or to the safety and security of the ICT systems and other users.

2.1 **For my own personal safety and security:**

- I understand that my use of school systems may be monitored and logged and can be made available to my teachers;
- I understand the need for complex passwords and will use a complex password for my Harris Federation Account;
- I will not use the same password for my Harris Federation account as I do for any of my other personal services or my social media accounts;
- I will not log in to a Harris Federation computer using any account other than my own;
- I will not share my Harris Federation account username and password with anyone, and I understand that the Federation will never send me an email requesting my password;
- I will not attempt to bypass the Federation's internet filtering system;
- I will not attempt to circumvent the Federation's IT security controls, access, or delete school data or damage school IT equipment or systems;
- I will not browse or access the dark web;
- I will be aware of the inherent dangers of communicating on-line with unknown and known individuals who may pose a potential threat;
- I will report any potential threats experienced communicating on-line to my form teacher;
- I will not disclose or share personal information about myself or others when on-line (this could include names, addresses, email addresses, telephone numbers, age, gender, educational details, financial details, photos etc.);
- If I arrange to meet people off-line that I have communicated with on-line, I will do so in a public place and take an adult with me;
- I will immediately report any unpleasant or inappropriate material or messages or anything that makes me feel uncomfortable when I see it on-line.

2.2 **I understand that everyone has equal rights to use technology as a resource and:**

- I understand that the academy systems and devices are primarily intended for educational use and that I will not use them for personal or recreational use unless I have permission;
- I will not try (unless I have permission from a member of staff) to make large downloads or uploads that might take up internet capacity and prevent other users from being able to carry out their work;

- I will not use the Academy systems or devices for on-line gaming, on-line gambling, internet shopping, file sharing, or video broadcasting (e.g. YouTube), unless I have permission from a member of staff to do so.

**2.3 I will act as I expect others to act toward me:**

- I will respect others' work and property and will not access, copy, remove or otherwise alter any other user's files, without the owner's knowledge and permission;
- I will be polite and responsible when I communicate with others, I will not use strong, aggressive or inappropriate language and I appreciate that others may have different opinions;
- I will not take or distribute images/photos of anyone without their permission.

**2.4 I recognise that the Academy has a responsibility to maintain the security and integrity of the technology it offers me and to ensure the smooth running of the Academy:**

- I will only use my own personal devices e.g. mobile phones in the academy if I have permission from an appropriate member of staff. I understand that, if I do use my own devices in the academy I will follow the rules set out in this agreement, in the same way as if I was using academy equipment;
- I understand the risks and will not try to upload, download or access any materials, including photos, which are illegal or inappropriate or may cause harm or distress to others, nor will I try to use any programs or software that might allow me to bypass the filtering / security systems in place to prevent access to such materials;
- I will immediately report any damage or faults involving equipment or software, however this may have happened;
- I will not open any hyperlinks in emails or any attachments to emails, unless I know and trust the person / organisation who sent the email, or if I have any concerns about the validity of the email (due to the risk of the attachment containing viruses or other harmful programmes);
- I will not install or attempt to install or store programmes of any type on any academy device, nor will I try to alter computer settings;
- I will only use social media sites with permission and at the times that are allowed.

**2.5 When using the internet for research or recreation, I recognise that:**

- I will ensure that I have permission from an appropriate member of staff to use the original work of others in my own work;
- Where work is protected by copyright, I will not try to download copies (including music and videos);
- When I am using the internet to find information, I should take care to check that the information that I access is accurate, as I understand that the work of others may not be accurate or truthful and may be a deliberate attempt to mislead me.

**2.6 I understand that I am responsible for my actions, both in and out of the Academy:**

- I understand that the academy has the right to take action against me if I am involved in incidents of inappropriate behaviour, that are covered in this agreement, when I am out of Academy and where they involve my membership of the Academy community; (examples would be cyber-bullying, use of images/photos or personal information);
- I understand that if I fail to comply with this Acceptable Use Policy Agreement, I will be subject to disciplinary action. This may include loss of access to the academy network / internet, detentions, suspensions, contact with parents and in the event of illegal activities involvement of the police.
